This year marks the 35th anniversary of the State Employee Charitable Giving Campaign (SECGC), and once again we invite you to make a difference by donating to your favorite nonprofits through workplace giving.

Your Impact

As a state employee, you make Montana stronger —not only through your service every day, but also through your generosity. Studies show that each dollar donated through SECGC generates a \$3 economic impact. That means together, employees have created more than \$33.6 million in benefits for Montana communities.

How to Give

Workplace giving is simple:

Click-and-Give: Visit secgc.mt.gov to donate online.

Payroll Deduction: Give a little each paycheck and watch it add up.

One-Time Donation:

Contribute by cash, check, debit, or credit card.

Last year, over 98% of employees gave online using Click-and-Give. Paper pledge forms are still available through your department coordinator if you prefer.

If you're new, welcome! Unsure how much to give? Consider starting with one hour's pay per pay period—or choose an amount that fits your budget. Whether \$5 or \$50, it all adds up to lifechanging impact.
